

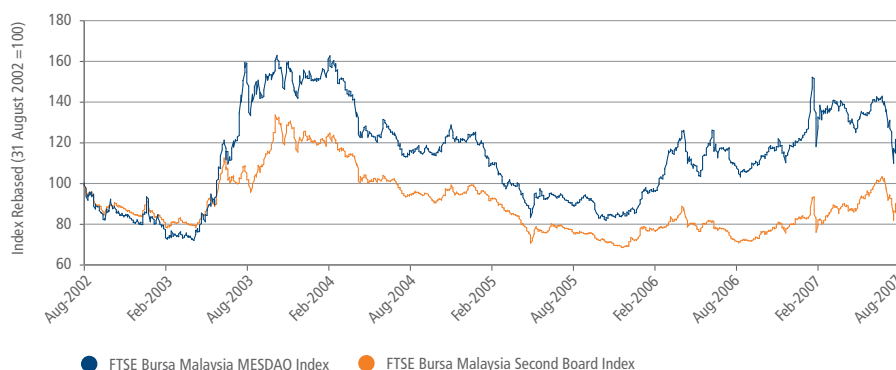
FTSE BURSA MALAYSIA SECOND BOARD & MESDAQ INDICES

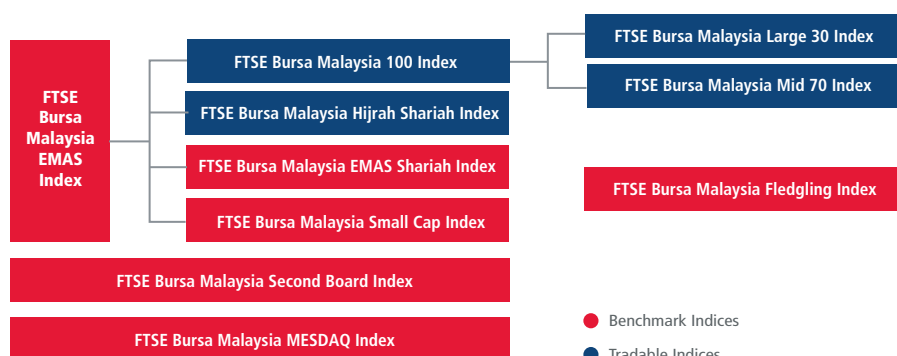
